Dear Parents/Guardians

This is to provide you with financial information about the contributions and charges that will apply at Waroona District High School in 2026.

For secondary students the total amount of Voluntary Contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained to **\$235.00** per student. The secondary costing is the same amount which can be claimed through the Secondary Assistance Scheme for those parents/guardians who are eligible.

2026 SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME – PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The Western Australian Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veterans' Affairs card which lists the student as a dependant.

Parents/guardians in receipt of the ABSTUDY School Allowance from the Department of Human Resources (Centrelink) are also eligible for the Secondary Assistance Scheme.

The allowance consists of two components:

\$235 Educational Program Allowance which is paid directly to the school and applied to charges and contributions.

\$115 Clothing Allowance is paid directly to the parent/guardian for uniform expenses. Please bring in Bank Account details e.g. BSB and Bank Account Number.

Applications for these allowances for students enrolled in Years 7 – 10, must be completed by the parent or guardian in **Term 1 prior to the closing date of Thursday 2 April 2026.** Applications cannot be processed after this date.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE CAN BE CLAIMED AT THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE BETWEEN 8.00AM AND 3.30PM DAILY FROM MONDAY 2 FEBRUARY 2026.

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EXTRA COST OPTIONAL CHARGES - SECONDARY

Charges refer to the provision of extra cost optional activities which are part of an education program which contributions do not cover. All of the following are optional and if no payment is received, an educational activity with a similar outcome will be provided to that student.

We stress that the following charges are set at the maximum amount. These charges are payable when the activity takes place.

Optional Charges	Max Cost Per Student
Excursions & Incursions : The School Board recognises the value of excursions for students and seeks to support teachers who co-ordinate them as part of teaching programs.	\$200.00
Swimming Carnivals & Trials : Students pay for the cost of entry to the pool.	\$20.00
Yearbook : Year 10 student publication of events and activities students have undertaken throughout the year.	\$30.00
Performing Arts : This fee will cover the costs of YohFest entry, costumes & transport.	\$250.00
Bush Rangers Shirts : A special shirt for when attending Bush Ranger activities, excursions and camps.	\$40.00
Bush Rangers Camps : students participate in various camps to enhance the teaching program.	\$200.00
Year 7 to 10 Country Week : The actual cost may be less depending on subsidy by fundraising and State Government Grants.	\$600
Interschool Sports : This fee will cover the cost of the bus hire.	\$50.00
Year 10 Leavers Jacket : A special jacket is arranged annually for Year 10 students only.	\$100.00
Year 10 Certificate I in Hospitality : students will receive an industry recognised IVET certificate on completion of this course.	\$220.00
School Social Dance : The School Dance is open to all Year 7-10 students. The cost of clothing is the parent's responsibility.	\$30.00
Whole School Fundraising : There are various activities such as Free Dress Days and Sausage Sizzles that are run during the year by the school. All activities are voluntary to students.	\$50.00
Scholastic Book Club : Approximately 8 opportunities per year to order books.	Optional
School Photo's : The school uses MSP Photography. Information for ordering photo's is provided closer to the date.	Optional
P&C Fundraising and activities : Fun runs, Mother's Day and Father's Day, Cake Stalls, Wood Raffles and general fundraising.	Optional
